Although I applaud your efforts to make our forest lands more user-friendly, I fear that certain sections may indeed have the opposite effect. In particular, the provisions to prohibit horses and bikes on designated trails, require permits to be obtained by all campers, and prohibit snow plowing on state forest roads, all serve to reduce access to our state forests.
