COMMENTS OF THE INDEPENDENT REGULATORY REVIEW COMMISSION

ON

PENNSYLVANIA EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY REGULATION NO. 30-50

RADIATION TRANSPORTATION EMERGENCY RESPONSE FUND

AUGUST 20, 1998

We have reviewed this proposed regulation from the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency (PEMA) and submit for your consideration the following objections and recommendations. Subsections 5.1(h) and 5.1(i) of the Regulatory Review Act (71 P.S. \S 745.5a(h) and (i)) specify the criteria the Commission must employ to determine whether a regulation is in the public interest. In applying these criteria, our Comments address issues that relate to clarity. We recommend that these Comments be carefully considered as you prepare the final-form regulation.

1. Section 117.4. Allocation of funds. - Clarity.

This section uses the terms "eligible state agency," "eligible applicant" and "eligible county." The definitions for "state agency," "applicant" and "county" are included in Section 117.1. However, there is no definition that includes the term "eligible." Eligible expenditures are set forth in Section 117.5. We suggest that Section 117.4 include a reference to Section 117.5 to provide the reader with information concerning eligibility.

2. Section 117.6. Application and review procedures for funding. - Clarity.

The proposed regulation deletes language in Subsection 117.6(c) that states PEMA will provide application forms and includes short descriptions of the forms. PEMA indicates that the language is being deleted because the forms are subject to change. However, PEMA will continue to provide applicants with these forms.

We recommend that the regulation retain a sentence that states the requisite application forms will be provided by PEMA. This eliminates the problem with updating descriptions of the forms in the regulation while notifying readers that PEMA will provide them with the necessary forms.
