## PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT

Principle 5. Advertising

\*\*\*

- (c) Advertising BY VETERINARIANS for emergency veterinary services shall provide information as to whether a veterinarian is on the premises; or on call, and as to any limitation on SHALL SPECIFY THE hours during which emergency services may not be ARE available.
- (1) For the purposes of this section, "on the premises" means that a veterinarian is physically present in AT the veterinary establishment and IS immediately available TO RENDER EMERGENCY SERVICES. and "oOn call" means that the A veterinarian is available TO RETURN CALLS REQUESTING EMERGENCY SERVICES WITHIN A REASONABLE TIME AND IS AVAILABLE TO RENDER EMERGENCY SERVICES within a reasonable time.
- (2) VETERINARIANS SHALL DISCLOSE SPECIFIC LIMITATIONS (I.E. EXOTICS/AVIAN/LARGE ANIMAL/SMALL ANIMAL) WHEN ADVERTISING EMERGENCY SERVICES.
