Regulation No. 57-204 Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission Cramming and Slamming

On May 19, 1999, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this proposed regulation from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC). This rulemaking amends 52 Pa. Code Chapter 64. The proposed regulation was published in the May 29, 1999 *Pennsylvania Bulletin* with a 30-day public comment period. The final-form regulation was submitted to the Commission on September 21, 2000.

This regulation standardizes local exchange company responses to customer complaints on cramming and slamming. Cramming is adding an unauthorized charge for products or services to a customer's bill. Slamming is changing a customer's telecommunications service provider without authorization.

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of the PUC (66 Pa.C.S. § 1501) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.
