Thank you for your correspondence dated August 21, 2000, and our subsequent telephone conversation this morning, regarding the Workers' Compensation Health & Safety Regulations. At this time, the Department would like to extend the opportunity to the AFL-CIO to discuss its concerns and recommendations as noted in its comments submitted to the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (IRRC) on August 4, 2000.

By means of background, the Department submitted the proposed Health & Safety regulations to IRRC and the standing committees on June 4, 1999. The proposed rulemaking was published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* on Saturday, June 19, 1999, thus commencing the 20 day public comment period. We have no record of the AFL-CIO responding at any time prior to, or during, this period. Almost 13 months later, on August 4, 2000 (less than one week prior to IRRC's scheduled public meeting to consider this rulemaking), we received comments from the AFL-CIO. On August 8, 2000, the Department withdrew the regulations to address a technical revision recommended by IRRC. We fully expect to resubmit the regulations, with any necessary adjustments, in the near future.

Although the Department is not required under the provisions of the Regulatory Review Act (Act) to formally respond to comments received outside of the public comment period as designated by the Act, we are always interested in hearing the AFL-CIO's thoughts on issues of mutual concern.
