The proposed regulation updates references to the official Campaign Finance Reporting Forms. Although the forms are being deleted from the regulation, the content of the reports and other related provisions continue to be delineated in Sections 177.1 through 177.8. Additionally, a provision is being added to notify filers that reports can be filed on diskette. (9) State the statutory authority for the regulation and any relevant state or federal court decisions. The regulatory amendments are adopted under Section 2621 of the Pennsylvania Election Code, Act of June 3, 1937, P.L. 1333, art. II, §201, 25 P.S. § 2621(a).

(10) Is the regulation mandated by any federal or state law or court order, or federal regulation? If yes, cite the specific law, case or regulation, and any deadlines for action.

The regulation is not mandated but the Secretary has the authority to develop forms and promulgate regulations pursuant to Section 2621(a) of the Pennsylvania Election Code, Act of June 3, 1937, P.L. 1333, art. II, §201, 25 P.S. § 2621(a).

(11) Explain the compelling public interest that justifies the regulation. What is the problem it addresses?

The existing reporting forms have been in place for many years. The Department has modernized the reporting forms that will ease the documentation for the filer. Additionally, the regulation allows the filer to utilize new technologies by filing on diskette in lieu of paper reports.

(12) State the public health, safety, environmental or general welfare risks associated with nonregulation.

None.

(13) Describe who will benefit from the regulation. (Quantify the benefits as completely as possible and approximate the number of people who will benefit.)

Those filers filing paper reports rather than diskette will benefit because of the improved format of the reporting forms. The general public, news media and others interested in accessing campaign finance data will also benefit by being able to better access campaign finance information.

(14) Describe who will be adversely affected by the regulation. (Quantify the adverse effects as completely as possible and approximate the number of people who will be adversely affected.)

The Election Bureau has not identified any group of individuals or entities who will be adversely affected by the regulation.

(15) List the persons, groups or entities that will be required to comply with the regulation. (Approximate the number of people who will be required to comply.)

Individuals filing political committee registration statements, candidate authorization of a political committee and appointment of a treasurer form, campaign finance reports and campaign finance statements are required to comply with the reporting requirements. Currently, the bureau receives approximately 12,000 reports per year.

(16) Describe the communications with and input from the public in the development and drafting of the regulation. List the persons and/or groups who were involved, if applicable.

In 1998 and 1999, the Department solicited input on the proposed changes to the reporting forms from candidates and political committees.

(17) Provide a specific estimate of the costs and/or savings to the regulated community associated with compliance, including any legal, accounting or consulting procedures which may be required.

The Election Bureau estimates that there will not be any additional legal, accounting or consulting procedures implicated in complying with the regulatory amendments.

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(18) Provide a specific estimate of the costs and/or savings to local governments associated with compliance, including any legal, accounting or consulting procedures which may be required.

Local governments will not be adversely affected by the regulation. Similar to the existing process, the Bureau provides the county election offices copies of the reporting forms for use by candidates who file at the local level.

(19) Provide a specific estimate of the costs and/or savings to state government associated with the implementation of the regulation, including any legal, accounting, or consulting procedures which may be required.

The Election Bureau will not incur an increase in administrative costs by implementing the regulation. Changes to and duplication of forms are completed within the Department.

This regulation will have no effect on other regulations of the Election Bureau or other state agencies.

Campaign Finance Forms

PREAMBLE

The Department of State, Bureau of Commissions, Elections and Legislation amends 4 Pa. Code Sections 174.1 (relating to reports of business entities), 176.2 (relating to registration forms and filing), 176.8 (relating to authorization of political committees), 177.1 (relating to general reports by candidates, political committees and other persons), 177.2 (relating to form and content of reports) and 177.9 (relating to official forms), as set forth in the Annex A.

The Notice of Proposed Rulemaking was published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin on March 4, 2000, 30 Pa. B. 1255 - 1257, and subject to a 30-day public comment period. The Department received no public comments and no comments from the House and Senate State Government Committees. The Independent Regulatory Review Commission (IRRC) made comments on May 4, 2000.

This amendment revises the references to four of the six existing forms in the current regulation at 4 Pa. Code § 177.9 and adds references to two additional forms, which have been in use since 1980 but never incorporated by reference in regulation. The Department has modernized all the campaign finance forms, which will ease documentation for filers. Additionally, the regulation incorporates a provision announcing that reports may be filed on diskette.

Although the existing forms are included in the current regulations, this rulemaking deletes the forms from the regulations in order to comply with Rule 2.10(a) of the Pennsylvania Code & Bulletin Style Manual, which recommends that the forms be referenced in regulations rather than adopted in regulations. The information required to be reported continues to be set forth in Chapters 174, 176 and 177.

While all candidates and political committees are provided with the revised forms for reporting during the 2000 elections, the Department will allow candidates and political committees to continue to file the prior version of the forms during the 2000

election year.

The IRRC asked the Department to clarify in the final-form regulation who has to file and what must be filed under each of the forms listed under 4 Pa. Code § 177.9(a). For those forms for which this filing information is already contained in other regulations, the IRRC suggested that appropriate cross-references be made between Section 177.9 and those relevant sections. The IRRC also requested that appropriate cross-references be made in those relevant sections to Section 177.9. These revisions were made as more specifically set forth in Part II of this Preamble.

Finally, the IRRC asked the Department to correct typographical errors in other relevant sections that refer to the forms contained in Section 177.9. An example of such an error occurs in Section 177.1(f) on independent expenditures, which had incorrectly referred to filing Campaign Financial Reports on DSBE Form 502. As noted in the Annex, the reference to independent expenditure reports was changed to filing Independent Expenditure Reports on DSEB Form 505.

As a result of the comments received to the proposed regulation from the IRRC and upon further review by the Department, Chapters 174, 176 and 177 were also revised to make editorial changes and make these regulations internally consistent as the Department added cross-references to the other chapters.

I. Statutory Authority

The Secretary has the authority to promulgate regulations on reporting forms under Section 201 of the Act of June 3, 1937, P. L. 1333, as amended, 25 P.S. §2621(a).

II. Description of Revisions

A. Chapter 174: Reports of Political Contributions

1. 174.1 (Business Entity)

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At the request of the IRRC, the Department added a cross-reference to Form DSEB 504 in Section 177.9 because this form is used to report contributions by non-bid contract recipients as required in Section 174.1.

B. <u>Chapter 176: Registration and Organization of Political</u> <u>Committees</u>

1. 176.2 (Forms and Filing)

At the request of the IRRC, the Department added a cross-reference to Form DSEB 500 in Section 177.9 and changed the previous incorrect reference from Form DSBE 501.

2. 176.8 (Authorization of political committee)

At the request of the IRRC, the Department added a cross-reference to Form DSEB 501 in Section 177.9 and made an additional editorial correction to the county board of elections.

C. Chapter 177: Reports by Candidates, Political Committees and Other Persons

- 1. §177.1 (General)
- (a) & (b) At the request of the IRRC, the Department added a cross-reference to Form DSEB 502 in Section 177.9 and made other editorial changes to make the references to the forms consistent with those in Section 177.9.
- (c) At the request of the IRRC, the Department added a cross-reference to Form DSEB 503 in Section 177.9.
- (f) At the request of the IRRC, the Department added a cross-reference to Form DSEB 505 in Section 177.9 and corrected the previous reference to DSBE Form 502.
- 2. (Form and content of reports)

In subsections (a), (b), (b)(4), (e) and (f), the Department made editorial changes to the title of Form DSEB 502, changing it from Campaign Financial Reports to Campaign Finance Reports to obtain consistency with Section 177.9.

In subsection (b)(7), the Department followed the suggestion of the IRRC to correct a reference to the Independent Expenditure Reports on Form DSEB 505 and to cross-reference that form to Section 177.9.

3. §177.9 (Official Forms)

The following four forms which were promulgated in 1980, at 10 Pennsylvania Bulletin 962, effective March 8, 1980, are revised and renamed as indicated below and in the Annex:

- (2) Form DSEB-501 (Authorization For a Political Committee To Receive Funds on Behalf of a Candidate);
- (3) Form DSEB-502 (Campaign Finance Report); and
- (4) Form DSEB-503 (Campaign Finance Statement).

The title of Form DSEB-501 was changed because the appointment of a treasurer is not done on that form because it already appears on Form DSEB-500. The titles of Forms DSEB-502 and DSEB-503 were changed from Campaign Expense to Campaign Finance because the Report includes not only campaign expenses but also receipts, contributions, in-kind contributions and unpaid debts. The Statement includes both receipts and disbursements.

The Department also proposes to revise the reference to two additional forms that have been in use since the regulations were last promulgated in 1980:

(1) Form DSEB-504 (Contributions By Non-bid Contract

Recipients); and

(2) Form DSEB-505 (Independent Expenditure Report).

Finally, a reference is added to Section 177.9 to indicate that reports will be accepted on diskette as long as it meets the technical specifications of the Department.

D. <u>Chapter 177: Forms of Reports by Candidates, Political</u> <u>Committees and Other Persons</u>

Copies of all of these forms and the technical specifications for diskette filing are available from the Bureau of Commissions, Elections and Legislation, Department of State, 302 North Office Building, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17120 or from the Department's website at www.dos.state.pa.us. The Secretary deletes from the regulations copies of the forms. Executive Order 1996-1 directs that agencies eliminate unnecessary regulatory provisions. The forms themselves are nonregulatory documents and do not impose any additional duties or liabilities on the general public or on the political committees that file reports. Furthermore, the Legislative Reference Bureau recommends that forms not be adopted in the Code and Bulletin but be referred to in regulations. See § 2.10 of the Pennsylvania Code & Bulletin Style Manual.

III. Fiscal Impact

This amendment will have no measurable fiscal impact on the Commonwealth, its political subdivisions, or the private sector because the Commonwealth charges no fees for filing these reports. The Commonwealth will continue to charge a nominal fee for photocopies of the reports. However, reports will be made available on the Department's web page. Therefore, individuals with access to the Internet would no longer need to pay to obtain copies of the campaign finance reports.

IV. Paperwork Requirements

Although the Department is revising its campaign finance

reporting forms, these amendments will not create new paperwork for other agencies of the Commonwealth. As in the past, county boards of elections will be required to reproduce and distribute the forms prescribed by the Secretary of the Commonwealth to local candidates and political committees.

V. Regulatory Review

Pursuant to Section 5.1(a) of the Regulatory Review Act, the Act of June 30, 1989 (P.L. 73, No. 19), as amended, 71 P.S. § 745.5.1(a), the Department submitted a copy of this proposed regulation on February 22, 2000 to the Independent Regulatory Review Commission and the Majority and Minority Chairmen of the House and Senate State Government Committees. In compliance with Section 5(c) of the Regulatory Review Act, 71 P.S. § 745.5(c), the Department also provided the new and former versions of the campaign finance forms.

In preparing the final form regulation, the Department considered the comments it had received from the IRRC.

(b) Only those business entities doing business in this Commonwealth shall be required to report <u>ON THE CURRENT VERSION</u> <u>OF FORM DSEB 504. AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 177.9</u>. Parent companies of subsidiaries doing business in this Commonwealth but which do not do business here themselves shall also be excluded, even where a director of the parent corporation also serves on the board of directors of the subsidiary. In that case, that director's knowledge is relevant only as it pertains to contributions of other directors of the subsidiary.

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CHAPTER 176. REGISTRATION AND ORGANIZATION OF POLITICAL COMMITTEES

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§ 176.2 Forms and filing

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(a) The Registration Statement shall be filed on THE CURRENT VERSION OF Form DSBE 501 DSEB 500. AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 177.9, which may be obtained from the Secretary or any county board of elections.

- § 176.8 Authorization of political committees
- (a) Any political committee receiving contributions on behalf of a candidate shall be authorized in writing by the candidate on THE CURRENT VERSION OF FORM DSEB-501, AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 177.9. The written authorization shall be filed with the Secretary or the respective Ecounty Board of Eelections, as appropriate.

* * * * *

CHAPTER 177. REPORTS BY CANDIDATES, POLITICAL COMMITTEES AND OTHER PERSONS

§177.1 General

- (a) Every political committee and candidate shall file cumulative annual Campaign Financial FINANCE Reports on THE CURRENT VERSION OF Form DSBE DSEB 502, AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 177.9.
- (b) Each treasurer of a political committee and each candidate which receives contributions or makes expenditures or incurs liabilities exceeding the sum of \$250 shall file Campaign Financial FINANCE Reports on THE CURRENT VERSION OF Form DSEE DSEB 502, AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 177.9, with the Secretary or the respective county board of elections, or both.
- (c) A treasurer of a political committee or a candidate which receives contributions or makes expenditures or incurs liabilities in an amount not exceeding the sum of \$250 shall file a sworn statement to that effect on THE CURRENT VERSION OF FORM

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DSEB 503, AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 177.9, with the Secretary or the respective county board of elections, or both.

* * * * *

(f) Every person, other than a political committee or candidate who makes independent expenditures expressly advocating the election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate or question appearing on the ballot, other than by contribution to a political committee or candidate, in an amount exceeding the sum of \$100 during a calendar year shall file Campaign Financial INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURE Reports on THE CURRENT VERSION OF Form DSBE 502 DSEB 505, AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 177.9, with the Secretary or the respective County Board of Elections, or both.

* * * * *

- §177.2 Form and content of reports.
- (a) The Campaign Financial FINANCE Reports shall be filed on THE CURRENT VERSION OF Form DSEB 502, which may be obtained from the Secretary or any County Board of Elections.
- (b) The Campaign Financial FINANCE Report, to be signed and sworn to by the individual submitting the report, shall include the following:

* * * * *

(4) Each and every expenditure, the date made, the full name and address of the person to whom made, and the purpose for which the expenditure was made; provided, however, that each Campaign Financial FINANCE Report of a political committee shall itemize only those expenditures made to influence the election or defeat of a candidate for nomination or election in this Commonwealth or a question appearing on the ballot in this Commonwealth and all other expenditures made outside this Commonwealth, not relevant to elections within this Commonwealth, shall be aggregated and reported as one lump sum.

* * * * *

(7) In addition, the Campaign Financial Report INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURE REPORTS ON THE CURRENT VERSION OF FORM DSEB 505, AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 177.9, filed by persons making independent expenditures shall contain the name of the candidates or questions supported or opposed.

* * * * *

- (e) Each Campaign Financial Finance Report shall contain a summary, on a separate page, of the information required by subsection (b).
- (f) Each Campaign Financial FINANCE Report of a political committee created solely for the purpose of influencing an election on behalf of a single candidate shall be accompanied by an affidavit of the candidate. The affidavit shall affirm that, to the best of the candidate's knowledge, the political committee has not violated the act of October 4, 1978 (P.L. 893, No. 1978-171) (25 P.S. § § 3221, 3222, 3222.1, 3223, 3224, 3225, 3225.1, 3226, 3227, 3228, 3229, 3230, 3230.1, 3231, 3232, 3233, 3234 Rep. 3241--3262).

Affiliated means (1) authorized committees of the same candidate, and (2) committees, including separate segregated funds, established, administered, maintained or controlled by the same corporation, unincorporated association, person or group of persons, including a parent, subsidiary, branch, division, dept. or local unit.

<u>Connected</u> means an organization which is not a political committee but which directly or indirectly establishes, maintains, controls or administers the registrant, such as a corporation, an unincorporated association, a membership organization, a cooperative or a trade association.

INSTRUCTIONS

This form is intended for the use of candidates, political committees and contributing lobbyists who are required to disclose contributions and expenditures. Candidates must file separate reports when they make expenditures or receive contributions on their own behalf and separate from their campaign committee. A candidate's report discloses contributions received and expenditures made individually by the candidate. A contributing lobbyist's report discloses only expenditures the lobbyist personally made to influence the outcome of a candidate's election.

Candidates and their authorized political committees file reports in the office where their nomination documents are filed. If the candidate's reports are filed with the Secretary of the Commonwealth, a copy of the reports filed by the candidate and the authorized committee must be filed with the County Board of Elections in the county in which the candidate resides.

REPORT COVER PAGE

The Report Cover Page identifies the filer, the type of report and what reporting period is covered. It also summarizes the detailed contribution and expenditure sections from the body of the report.

Filer Identification Number - This number is assigned by the Bureau of Commissions, Elections and Legislation to candidates and committees who register and file with the Secretary of the Commonwealth. A candidate's filer identification number is assigned by the Bureau when the candidate files nomination petitions. A political committee or lobbyist filer identification number is assigned when the committee or lobbyist files registration documents in the Bureau.

Report Filed By - Please indicate which type of filer you are by checking the appropriate box on the cover page.

Name of Filing Committee, Candidate or Lobbyist, Street Address, City, State, Zip Code - Please enter appropriate name and address.

Type of Report - Please place an "X" by the applicable report type.

Amendment Report - Check "Yes" only if the report is being filed to correct, add to, or in some way change a report that has already been filed.

Termination Report - Check "Yes" only if the filer has no cash balance, no unpaid debts or obligations, and wishes to cease operation. Contributing lobbyists may file a termination report if they do not anticipate making further contributions to influence the outcome of a candidate's election.

Filing Method - Indicate whether the complete report is filed on paper, or if the report is filed by diskette accompanied by the signed and notarized cover sheet.

Name of Office Sought - If filed by a candidate or candidate's committee, indicate office sought.

Date of Election - If this is a pre- or post-primary/election report, indicate the date of the primary or election.

District Number - If filed by a candidate or candidate's committee, indicate district in which candidate is seeking office.

Office Code, Party Code and County Code - If filed by candidate or candidate's committee, refer to code charts at the back of this report form. Enter the corresponding code letters for the office sought and the political party of the candidate; enter the corresponding code number for the county of residence of the candidate. Candidates for local offices who file only with the County Board of Elections should enter Office Code OTH for Other Offices.

Summary of Receipts and Expenditures - Enter the appropriate dates of the reporting period covered.

Amount Brought Forward From Last Report (Item A) - The balance, if any, as of the first day of the reporting period. For committees, it is the amount reported as the ending cash balance on the previous report filed, if any.

Items B through G - See detailed instructions on each corresponding schedule.

Affidavit Section - Must be sworn to by the filer acknowledging the accuracy of the report (Part I). On reports filed by a candidate's authorized committee, the candidate must sign an additional affidavit (Part II).

Page Number - Calculate the total number of pages in the completed report and indicate on top of cover page. Subsequent pages should be numbered consecutively.

Reports Filed on Diskette: The cover page must accompany all filings, including diskette filings. Diskette filings must also meet the technical specifications of the Department. These specifications are available at www.dos.state.pa.us or by contacting the Bureau.

Item 1: Unitermized Contributions and Receipts represents the total amount of contributions and receipts of \$50.00 or less in the aggregate *per contributor* received during the reporting period. Items 2, 3 and 4: Enter the total for each section from the corresponding schedules in the report (Part A, Part B, Part C, Part D and Part E).

Enter the total from Schedule I on the Report Cover Page, Item B.

Definition of Contribution: Any payment, gift, subscription, assessment, contract, payment for services, dues, loan, forbearance, advance or deposit of money or any valuable thing, to a candidate or political committee made for the purpose of influencing any election in this Commonwealth or for paying debts incurred by or for a candidate or committee before or after any election. "Contribution" shall also include the purchase of tickets for events such as dinners, luncheons, rallies and other fund-raising events; the granting of discounts or rebates by television and radio stations and newspapers not extended on an equal basis to all candidates for the same office; and any payments provided for the benefit of any candidate, including any payments for the services of any person serving as an agent of a candidate or committee by a person other than the candidate or committee or a person whose expenditures the candidate or committee must report under the act. The word "contribution" includes any receipt or use of anything of value received by a political committee from another political committee and also includes any return on investments by a political committee. (See 25 P.S. §3241)

Instructions for Reporting Contributions

The aggregate total of contributions from an individual contributor within a reporting period determines which part of the report form should be used to disclose a contribution or receipt. The form is designed to list the dates and amounts of as many as three separate contributions from the same source in one line item.

Contributions and receipts of \$50 or less, per contributor, during the reporting period, need not be itemized on the report. The total amount of all unitemized contributions should appear on Schedule I, Contributions and Receipts Detailed Summary Page, Line 1. A record must be kept of the receipt dates of contributions and the names and addresses of each person from whom a contribution of over \$10 has been received.

Contributions and receipts over \$50 to \$250 - report the name of the contributor, mailing address, amount and date received on Schedule I, Part A, "Contributions Received from Political Committees," or Part B "All Other Contributions."

Contributions and receipts over \$250 - report the name of the contributor, mailing address, occupation, employer's name and address, amount and date received on Schedule I, Part C, "Contributions Received from Political Committees," or Part D, "All Other Contributions."

Receipts - Use Part E, "Other Receipts" to report all other monetary receipts or income; e.g. refunds received, interest income, returned checks and prior expenditures that were returned to the filer during the reporting period.

Address - In all Parts, a complete address, including zip code, must be provided. Space is provided for the Zip Code Plus Four. The State block should be completed with the U.S. Postal Service's standard two-letter abbreviation, such as PA for Pennsylvania.

Date - all date blocks in the report must be completed with eight digits. For instance, March 24, 2000 would appear as 03 24 2000.

Total - of each Part should be transferred to the appropriate section on the **Schedule I**, "Contributions and Receipts **Detailed Summary Page**" (Page 2 of the report form).

Occupation and Employer - Part D, which lists individuals who have contributed over \$250, also requires the occupation and name and address of the employer of the contributor. Report the principal place of business of any contributor who is self-employed.

(See 25 P.S. §3241)

Instructions for Reporting Expenditures

Pursuant to state law, the Statement of Expenditures requires the filer to report the purposes for which funds were expended, the name and address of the entity to whom the expenditure was made, and the amount and date of each expenditure.

Vouchers for all expenditures over \$25.00 must be retained by the candidate or committee treasurer and shall be available for public inspection or copying. Filers are not required to submit vouchers with reports; however, vouchers must be retained for a period of three years.

Transactions between a candidate and his/her committee should be recorded on both the candidate's and committee's reports. For example, if a candidate contributes to or loans the committee money, the amount should appear on the candidate's report as an expenditure and on the committee's report as a receipt. A loan must also be reported by the recipient on the Statement of Unpaid Debts (Schedule IV).

Annual Report - Reporting period closes December 31. File by January 31 of the year following the reporting period. Filed by all candidates for nomination or election, political committees and contributing lobbyists.

Political committees required to file pre-election reports must also file post-election reports.

Postmarks - are acceptable as proof of timely filing where report is sent by first class mail and postmarked by the U.S. Postal Service no later than the day prior to the filing deadline.

Late filing fee - A late filing fee of \$10.00 for each day or part of the day (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays) that the report is overdue, plus an additional fee of \$10.00 for the first six days that a report is overdue will be assessed.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR REPORTING CONTRIBUTIONS

Definition of Contribution: Any payment, gift, subscription, assessment, contract, payment for services, dues, loan, forbearance, advance or deposit of money or any valuable thing, to a candidate or political committee made for the purpose of influencing any election in this Commonwealth or for paying debts incurred by or for a candidate or committee before or after any election. "Contribution" shall also include the purchase of tickets for events such as dinners, luncheons, rallies and all other fund-raising events.

Reporting Requirements: It is the aggregate total of contributions from an individual contributor within a reporting period which determines the following reporting requirements:

- (1) The total of individual contributions and receipts of \$50 or less a record must be kept of names, address and dates of each person from whom a contribution of over \$10 has been received.
- (2) Contributions and receipts over \$50 to \$250 name, mailing address, amount and date.
- (3) Contributions and receipts over \$250 name, mailing address, occupation, employer's name and address, amount and date.

Recommended Contributions and Receipts Procedures: The following record keeping procedures are designed to ensure all contributions and receipts are properly recorded and reported:

- (1) Record all cash receipts promptly in the accounting records, include all required information relating to contributors' names, addresses, dates received, contribution amounts and, when applicable, employers' names and address.
- (2) All currency receipts must be recorded and should be deposited. Undeposited currency should not be used to make expenditures. If small currency expenditures are sometimes necessary, consider establishing a petty cash fund, under the responsibility of the candidate or in the case of a committee, the treasurer or the assistant treasurer, who would account for all receipts and disbursements of the fund.
- (3) Deposit all cash receipts promptly. It is helpful to subtotal the cash receipts journal each time a deposit is made and compare the subtotal to the deposit slip total to ensure all receipts are properly accounted for.
- (4) Transactions between the candidate and committee should be recorded on both campaign reports; e.g., if a candidate contributed or loaned his/her committee money, the amount should appear on the candidate's report as an expenditure and on the committee's report as a receipt. Loans must also be recorded in the Unpaid Debts and Obligation Schedule of a report.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR REPORTING EXPENDITURES

Definition of Expenditure: The payment, distribution, loan or advancement of money or any valuable thing by a candidate, political committee or other person for the purpose of influencing the outcome of an election.

Reporting Requirements: In the summary of expenditures, itemize each expenditure to include the full name and mailing address of the person to whom the expenditure was made, the purpose and the amount of the expenditure.

You are not required to submit vouchers with this report. However, you must retain them for a period of three years. Chapter 177.2 of the regulations more fully describes "vouchers" as receipted bills showing the identification of the person to whom the expenditure is made and the amount, date and purpose of the expenditure. If a receipted bill is unavailable, the regulations also consider the following as acceptable alternatives:

- (1) The cancelled check showing payment of the bill.
- (2) The bill, invoice or other memorandum of the transaction, supplied by the payee, and containing the same information as a receipted bill above.

Recommended Expenditure Procedures: The following record keeping procedures are designed to ensure all expenditures are properly recorded and reported.

- (1) Make expenditures by check rather than currency. Using checks will improve record keeping and control since check expenditures not recorded or recorded incorrectly can be identified and corrected by comparing returned checks to amounts recorded.
- (2) Require vendors to furnish invoices or other supporting documents for all expenditures.
- (3) Treasurers and assistant treasurers making out-of-pocket expenditures on behalf of the candidate or committee should be instructed to obtain invoices or other documents from the vendor to support the expenditure, and reimbursement to the individual should be based on amounts shown on such supporting documents. Reimbursement should be made by check.
- (4) Expenditures made involving no invoices (i.e., contributions to other political committees or loan repayments) should be evidenced by copies of cancelled checks.
- (5) If small currency expenditures are sometimes necessary, record the date, amount, purpose, and recipient's name in the underlying records at the time the disbursement is made.
- (6) Transactions between the candidate and committee-should be recorded on both campaign reports: e.g., if a candidate contributed or loaned his/her committee money, the amount should appear on the candidate's report as an expenditure and on the committee's report as a receipt. Loans must also be recorded in the Unpaid Debts and Obligation Schedule of a report.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING

The Pennsylvania Election Code in Section 1626 (G) provides:

"Every person other than a political committee or candidate who makes independent expenditures expressly advocating the election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate, or question appearing on the ballot, other than by a contribution to a political committee or candidate, in an aggregate amount in excess of one hundred dollars (\$100) during a calendar year shall file with the appropriate supervisor, on a form designed by the Secretary of the Commonwealth, a report which shall include the same information required of a candidate or political committee receiving such a contribution and, additionally, the name of the candidate or question supported or opposed. Reports required by this section shall be filed on dates on which reports by political committees making expenditures are required to report under this section."

INSTRUCTIONS

This form is to be prepared by any person (including organizations) who independently expend money to influence the election of any candidate or question appearing on the ballot WHERE THE AMOUNT EXCEEDS \$100 DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR.

You, the filer, must determine the appropriate date(s) to file this form by establishing the date when the expenditure(s) exceeded \$100. The date for filing this form is then calculated by reviewing the reporting dates for candidates and political committees to file reports at the election which you have expended money to influence.

If you do not intend to expend any additional money after completing this form, then you may indicate that this is your final report by checking the block marked "termination."

DETERMINING AMOUNT TO REPORT

You, the filer, are required to report the total amount which was expended as accurately as you can by reviewing any information which is available to you.

Schedule for Filing:

For Candidates and Political Committes:

First Reporting -

By Sixth Tuesday before election day. Reporting period closes the 50th day prior to the

election.

(STATEWIDE CANDIDATES AND COMMITTEES SUPPORTING SUCH CANDIDATES ONLY)

Second Reporting Period -

File Second Friday before election day. Reporting period closes 15 days before the election. (ALL CANDIDATES AND COMMITTEES SUPPORTING CANDIDATES)

Third Reporting Period -

File 30 days after election day. Reporting period closes 20 days after the election. (ALL CANDIDATES AND COMMITTEES SUPPORTING CANDIDATES)

Annual Reporting Period -

File by January 31st of the following year. Include all receipts and expenditures up to December 31st.

Political committees and political action committees which file pre-election reports/statements must file at all subsequent reporting deadlines for that election.

LATE FILING PENALTY

A penalty of \$10.00 for each day or part of the day (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays) that the report is overdue, plus an additional fee of \$10.00 for each of the first six days that a report is overdue will be assessed.

Postmarks are acceptable as proof of timely filing where report is sent by first class mail and postmarked by the United States Postal Service no later than the day prior to the filing deadline.
