Regulation 16A-644

State Board of Auctioneer Examiners

PROPOSAL: Regulation 16A-644 amends 49 PA Code, Chapter 1, regulations of the State Board of Auctioneer Examiners. The amendment makes revisions to the schedule of Board fees by adding six new fees for services for which there is currently no charge.

The proposed Rulemaking was published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin on May 6, 2000. The Professional Licensure Committee has until June 26, 2000, to submit comments on the regulation.

ANALYSIS: Pursuant to Sec. 6(a) of the Auctioneer and Auction Licensing Act, 63 P.S. Sec. 734.6(a), the Board is required to meet expenditures through revenues raised by fees, fines and civil penalties. The Board proposes to establish six new fees identified in a recent audit as attributable to requests by licensees for services or Board approval or action as required by the act or regulation:

Application to Change Sponsor	\$ 0.00	\$ 15.00
Application to Change Auction House or Auction Company License	\$ 0.00	\$ 15.00
Non-resident Exam Eligibility Review	\$ 0.00	\$ 25.00
Certification of Scores, Permit or Registration	\$ 0.00	\$ 25.00
Verification of License or Approval	\$ 0.00	\$ 15.00

RECOMMENDATIONS: It is recommended that the Professional Licensure Committee take no formal action until final form regulations are promulgated.
