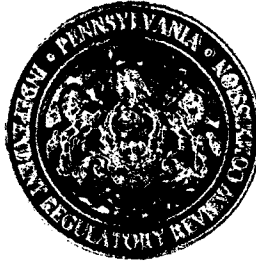

**State Board of Nursing Regulation No. 16A-5113
Biennial Renewal Fees**

Section 5(g) of the Regulatory Review Act provides that the Commission is deemed to have approved a final-form regulation when: the Commission did not file comments on the proposed regulation; the agency did not change the regulation from proposed to final-form; and the Standing Committees did not convey any recommendations, objections or comments on the regulation as proposed or in final-form.
