Reporting of Certain HIV Test Results, CD4 T-Lymphocyte Counts
Below a Certain Level, and Perinatal Exposure of Newborns to HIV

Dear Secretary Zimmerman:

I have serious concerns with this proposed regulation. Specifically, I recommend that you reconsider the following provisions:

- 1) Names-based reporting will create an unnecessary risk of both reduced HIV testing and delayed treatment for those Pennsylvanians who are HIV+;
- 2) Limiting anonymous-testing sites will similarly create an unnecessary risk of both reduced HIV testing and delayed treatment for those Pennsylvanians who are HIV+;
- 3) There is a total failure to describe the security systems that will be used to protect the medical information that will be transmitted electronically,
- 4) The discrepancies between this regulation and one you submitted last year, DOH 10-156, Reporting of Communicable and Non-communicable Diseases, will cause confusion and uncertainty about who is required to report AIDS cases.

The outcry against names-based reporting by medical providers, AIDS/HIV service providers and people living with AIDS/HIV is telling. It is inconceivable that the decision to pursue names-based reporting will not harm Pennsylvanian's lives. There is no good reason to take this risk. Even the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recognize that unique-identifier reporting will provide the necessary information for the public health system to control the spread of this disease.

I hope that we can begin discussions to correct the deficiencies in this regulation. Thank you.
