On April 10, 2001, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this proposed regulation from the Department of Health (Department). This rulemaking amends 28 Pa. Code Chapter 27. The proposed regulation was published in the April 21, 2001 *Pennsylvania Bulletin* with a 30-day public comment period. The final-form regulation was submitted to the Commission on May 15, 2002. On May 31, 2002, the Commission received a request from the Department to toll consideration of this final-form regulation to make four minor clarifications. Also on May 31, 2002, the Department submitted its revisions to the final-form regulation to the Commission.

This regulation adds three types of AIDS-related infections or conditions to the list of communicable and noncommunicable diseases that are subject to name-based reporting. These three infections or conditions include: HIV, CD4 T-lymphocyte test results with a count of less than 200 cells/uL or less than 14 percent of total lymphocytes, and perinatal exposure of a newborn to HIV. In addition to reporting requirements, the regulation allows anonymous testing at Department-designated anonymous testing sites.

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of the Department (35 P.S. §521.16) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.

BY ORDER OF THE COMMISSION:

This regulation is approved.
