Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission
Financial Reporting Requirements for All
Telecommunications Carriers

On August 27, 2001, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this proposed regulation from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC). This rulemaking amends 52 Pa. Code §§ 63.31 – 63.33, 71.3 and 71.9. The proposed regulation was published in the September 8, 2001 *Pennsylvania Bulletin* with a 30-day public comment period. The final-form regulation was submitted to the Commission on January 24, 2002.

The regulation updates the existing telephone utility classifications and streamlines reporting requirements for incumbent local exchange carriers (ILECs) and competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs). The regulation allows CLECs to use accounting methods other than the Uniform System of Accounts as long as they report to the PUC which method they are using. Finally, existing requirements for quarterly and annual rate-of-return financial reports are clarified to apply only to ILECs, and the quarterly reports are reduced to semi-annual reports.

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of the PUC (66 Pa.C.S.A. § 501) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.

## BY ORDER OF THE COMMISSION:

This regulation is approved.
