Thank you for your letter on behalf of the Buckingham Township Board of Supervisors making me aware of their concerns about the details and implementation schedule of the Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code (PUCC), Act 45 of 1999.

As of today's date, I'm advised by staff to the Department of Labor and Industry that the <u>Proposed Administration and Enforcement Regulation</u> has been finalized and prepared for publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*. When this regulation is printed in the *Bulletin*, a thirty-day public comment period will begin.

During the public comment period, the Department will hold three public meetings to receive comments on the proposal. I enclose information on the dates and locations of these meetings for your information. All comments, whether presented at the meetings or submitted in writing directly to the Department, will be considered and addressed.

The Department's final-form regulation detailing the <u>Training and Certification Requirements of the Uniform Construction Code</u> (UCC) was published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* on April 13, 2002. This regulation took effect on July 12, 2002, and the Department has begun registering and certifying code officials. Note that, until the UCC takes effect, registration or certification is not mandatory.

Some of the information on the website includes an implementation update, code training and certification, considerations for local governments, and a number of frequently asked questions.

Dear Senator Lemmond:

I am writing on behalf of Buckingham Township Board of Supervisors, Wayne County, PA. At their August 6th meeting the supervisors asked WIDCO to support them and their concerns about the details and implementation schedule of the Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code (PUCC), Act 45 of 1999.

The Board feels that this Act poses an excessive burden on the residents of the township. and the municipality in its efforts to comply with the Act. Specifically, they feel that the PUCC does not allow native Pennsylvania Hemlock lumber to be used in construction and it also requires too many inspections by too few trained inspectors. Lack of available inspectors would be a hindrance in development and growth by the townships. The Township also needs to have additional information on implementation for training sessions and various aspects of the Code.
