On September 4, 2002 the Liquor Control Board submitted final-omitted regulation #54-58 dealing with transporters-for-hire to the Senate Law and Justice Committee, the House Liquor Control Committee, and the Independent Regulatory Review Commission, as well as the Office of Attorney General for regulatory review.

Because the language in Annex A of the regulation submitted to you does not clearly distinguish between transporter-for-hire licenses and other types of licenses, I respectfully request that the regulation be withdrawn. Regulation #54-58 with the proper changes to Annex A will then be resubmitted.

I have enclosed copies of withdrawal letters delivered on this date to the standing committees of the Senate and House.
