Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board
Chapter 9. Transportation, Importation,

On October 3, 2002, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this regulation from the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board (Board). This rulemaking amends 40 Pa. Code Chapter 9. Notice of proposed rulemaking was omitted for this regulation; it will become effective upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*.


This final-omitted regulation amends existing regulations to allow Board-licensed transporters-for-hire to enter into agreements with non-licensed contractors. The regulation also eliminates a provision that requires notification to the Board when a vehicle used for the transportation of alcohol is taken out of service or sold.

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of the Board (47 P.S. § 2-207(i)) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.
