I have a copy of the proposed rulemaking that was reported in the Pennsylvania Bulletin Oct. 26, 2002. I would like clarification on section 7.91. Step 3 says to dry with a clean towel. If some items aren't completely dry, what other way is accepted as drying them? Are they allowed to be dried out in the open (as in air dried)? Can they be left in the open laying on a clean towel to dry? Also, the storing process of equipment..it says objects shall be stored in a clean, dry, and closed container. We use roller carts, does this mean that we can't store rollers and clips in roller carts anymore? Or are roller carts considered closed containers?
