State Board of Vehicle Manufacturers,
Dealers and Salespersons
Established Place of Business for Dealers

On October 17, 2002, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this proposed regulation from the State Board of Vehicle Manufacturers, Dealers and Salespersons (Board). This rulemaking amends 49 Pa. Code § 19.18. The proposed regulation was published in the November 2, 2002 *Pennsylvania Bulletin* with a 30-day public comment period. The Board resubmitted the proposed regulation on February 4, 2003, pursuant to Section 5(e) of the Regulatory Review Act, which was in effect at the time the regulation was proposed. The final-form regulation was submitted to the Commission on October 1, 2004.

This regulation establishes an exemption to the grading and surfacing requirements for vehicle display areas. This exemption allows vehicle dealers to have a non-conforming display area for up to five vehicles provided the public is not permitted in the display area.

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of the Board (63 P.S. § 818.4(a)(9)) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.
