Regulation No. 11-216 Underground Storage Tank Indemnification Board Fees and Collection Procedures

On October 25, 2002, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this regulation from the Underground Storage Tank Indemification Board (Board). This rulemaking amends 25 Pa. Code Chapter 977. Notice of proposed rulemaking was omitted for this regulation; it will become effective upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*.

This final-omitted rulemaking increases the gallon fee from \$0.001 per gallon to \$0.01; the capacity fee from \$0.02 per gallon of capacity to \$0.075; and reflects the increase of the limits of liability prescribed by Act 99 of 2001. The fee increases are needed to ensure the solvency of the Underground Storage Tank Indemnification Fund based on an actuarial analysis.

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of the Underground Storage Tank Indeminification Board (35 P.S. § 6021.705) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.
