Regulation No. 17-65  
Pennsylvania State Police  
Use of Unmarked Vehicles

On February 4, 2004, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this proposed regulation from the Pennsylvania State Police (State Police). This rulemaking amends 37 Pa. Code Chapter 42. The proposed regulation was published in the February 14, 2004 *Pennsylvania Bulletin* with a 30-day public comment period. The final-form regulation was submitted to the Commission on October 4, 2004.


This regulation establishes rules for the use of unmarked police vehicles by police officers as mandated by Act 75 of 2001.

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of the State Police (75 Pa.C.S.A. § 3328(a)) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.
