We submit for your consideration the following comments that include references to the criteria in the Regulatory Review Act (71 P.S. § 745.5b) which have not been met. The Coal and Clay Mine Subsidence Insurance Board (Board) must respond to these comments when it submits the final-form regulation. The public comment period for this regulation closed on April 5, 2004. If the final-form regulation is not delivered within two years of the close of the public comment period, the regulation will be deemed withdrawn.

#### Section 401.13. Coverage limits and premiums for insurance. - Clarity.

The term "agent" is used in this section and other sections of 25 Pa. Code Chapter 401. However, this term is not defined. We understand the term refers to employees of the Department of Environmental Protection working on behalf of the Board. To improve clarity and avoid confusion, the Board should define the term "agent."
