Regulation No. 14-491 (#2452) Department of Public Welfare Home Health Agency Services

On November 30, 2004, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this proposed regulation from the Department of Public Welfare. This rulemaking amends 55 Pa. Code Chapter 1249. The proposed regulation was published in the December 11, 2004 *Pennsylvania Bulletin* with a 30-day public comment period. The final-form regulation was submitted to the Commission on February 16, 2007.

This regulation deletes requirements from Chapter 1249 that require a recipient of Medical Assistance (MA) to be "homebound" to qualify for Home Health Agency (HHA) services. This regulation also moves HHA service visit limitations from regulation to the MA program fee schedule.

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of the Department of Public Welfare (62 P.S. § 403) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.
