We received the letter dated February 8, 2006, from James McNulty, Secretary of the Public Utility Commission. According to Mr. McNulty, the PUC has reopened the public comment period for the above regulation, in order to seek additional comments on eight enumerated issues. The reopened public comment period will end on April 7, 2005.

Within 30 days of the close of the reopened public comment period, IRRC may submit additional comments to the PUC and the designated House and Senate Committees, pursuant to Section 5(g) of the Regulatory Review Act (71 P.S. §745.5(g)). The designated Committees may also submit comments any time prior to delivery of the final-form regulation.

We request that the PUC submit to the IRRC and the Committees copies of any comments received, within five days of receipt, in accordance with Section 5(c) of the Regulatory Review Act (71 P.S. § 745.5(c)), and IRRC Regulations, 1 Pa. Code § 305.2.
