Regulation No. 16A-608

On March 29, 2005, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this proposed regulation from the State Board of Vehicle Manufacturers, Dealers and Salespersons (Board). This rulemaking amends Pa. Code 49 Chapter 19. The proposed regulation was published in the April 23, 2005 *Pennsylvania Bulletin* with a 30-day public comment period. The final-form regulation was submitted to the Commission on November 28, 2005.


This regulation sets forth the procedural requirements for litigants to follow in vehicle protest matters before the Board. The procedural requirements supplement Part II of Pa. Code Chapter 1, relating to General Rules of Administrative Practice and Procedure.

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of the Board (63 P.S. §§818.4(a)(9), 818.7, 818.8, 818.13 and 818.27) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.
