Kindly allow me to comment on the proposed amendment to Section 121.30. The amendment currently reads as follows:

§ 121.30. [Still payable list] Section 306(h) payments (77 P. S. § 583).

(a) Under section 306(h) of the **[Workers' Compensation Act] act (77 P. S. § 583), [insurance carriers and self-insured employers, including the State Workmen's Insurance Fund,] insurers shall [submit] have submitted** a listing of all pre-March 17, 1968, cases on which compensation is **[still]** payable on July 1, 1975. This listing must have been received in the Bureau no later than July 1, 1975., **and should contain the following particulars:**

- (1) Name of claimant.**
- (2) Social Security number.**
- (3) Bureau file number.**
- (4) Claimant's date of birth.**
- (5) Date of accident.**
- (6) Name of employer.**
- (7) Insurer number.**
- (8) Current compensation rate.**

- (9) Adjusted compensation rate.**
- (10) Reimbursable difference.**
- (11) Period of payment schedule.]**

As you know, this language was drafted before the enactment of Act 147 of 2006. Since Act 147 impacts upon Section 306(h) payments, I suggest that the Bureau review and revise the proposed amendment as needed to account for the new legislation.
