State Board of Education
Academic Standards and Assessment for
Career Education and Work

On September 26, 2005, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this proposed regulation from the State Board of Education. This rulemaking amends 22 Pa. Code Chapter 4. The proposed regulation was published in the November 5, 2005 *Pennsylvania Bulletin* with a 30-day public comment period. The final-form regulation was submitted to the Commission on April 21, 2006.


This regulation amends Chapter 4 to incorporate academic standards in the area of Career Education and Work.

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of the State Board of Education (24 P.S. § 26-2603-B(k)) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.
