I am writing to express my concern and objection about the proposed regulation change on Financial Institution Security Equipment, 61 PA Code, section 46.9.

The proposed Sales and Use Tax regulation change will substantially increase the taxation burden already imposed on the ever-decreasing list of remaining independent Pennsylvania financial institutions. I am also concerned that this proposed, back-door, tax increase would be imposed by regulatory change rather than the democratic vote of elected and accountable legislators.

I urge you to reject the proposed repeal of 61 PA Code, section 46.9.
