Department of Community and Economic

On January 23, 2006, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this proposed regulation from the Department of Community and Economic Development (Department). This rulemaking amends 12 Pa. Code Chapter 143. The proposed regulation was published in the February 4, 2006 *Pennsylvania Bulletin* with a 30-day public comment period. The final-form regulation was submitted to the Commission on July 18, 2006.

This regulation sets fees charged to manufacturers and retailers to cover the costs of extraordinary follow-up monitoring and inspections.

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of the Department (35 P.S. § 1656.6(c)) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.
