Throughout the chapter it makes reference to both Jails and County Prisons. I believe that there are specific definitions for both. As an example: Jails hold both sentenced and unsentenced inmates (prisoners) and Prisons only hold sentenced inmates. I know that most county institutions call themselves Prisons or DOC's. Across the country we are classified as jails and state/federal facilities are classified as Prisons. A simple solution to the Chapter would be to reference both: "Jails/County Prisons" through the section.
