The purpose of this letter is to address the topic of "Mercury Emission Reduction Requirements for Electric Generating Units (#7-405).

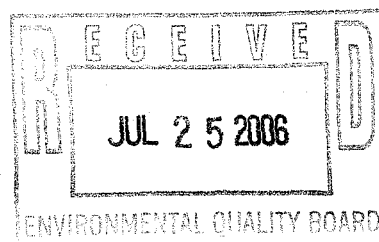
It is with dismay that I read that my home state of Pennsylvania is #2 in the country for mercury emissions from coal-fired power plants. While it is understandable that the coal and electric power industries would balk at making any changes that would affect their profit margin, there are other factors that I consider to be more important than their "bottom line."

The health of Pennsylvania's current and future residents is not a matter to be taken lightly. I recently heard a radio broadcast where women who were pregnant or hoping to become pregnant were strongly warned to limit their intake of certain types of fish because of the potential for serious consequences due to the high mercury levels in fish such as tuna. Parents were also advised not to serve these same types of fish to their young children more often than once a week because of the health dangers associated with ingesting these same high levels of mercury.

Therefore, I wish to go on record as supporting the DEP proposal to require coal fired power plants to cut their mercury emissions 90% by 2015 at the latest. I also urge you to oppose any pollution trading plan and to make sure that all coal plants reduce their mercury pollution.

Mercury is a neurotoxin that can cause brain damage and developmental disorders in children ~~are~~ mercury poisoning in adults. Our state is currently the 2nd Worst in the nation for mercury pollution, and our fish are so full of this toxin that state officials have released warnings about how much fish is safe to consume. Pregnant women and children with still-developing brains run the risk of serious health problems if they eat even a small amount of mercury - that is - if they eat any fish caught in PA state waters at all.

This is not fair. Our coal power plants could prevent the problem at its source, as plants in other states are already doing. To allow them to trade pollution credits with other plants shows serious disregard for the people and the environment in Pennsylvania, where we develop hot spots with more poison than anywhere else in the nation.
