I'm writing to express strong support of Pennsylvania's Department of Environmental Protection's proposed rule to reduce mercury pollution from Pennsylvania's coal-fired power plants 90% by 2015. Mercury contamination in fish poses a serious risk to all citizens – it's especially dangerous for pregnant women and children. Exposure to even small amounts of mercury can affect the way children learn, think, memorize and behave. Mercury levels in Pennsylvania are so high that the state has issued advisories warning people, especially women and children, to avoid or limit eating fish from all of Pennsylvania's waterways. Even with such warnings in place, the EPA estimates that one out of six U.S. women of child-bearing age has levels of mercury in her blood that are unsafe for a developing fetus.

Coal-fired power plants are responsible for about 80% of Pennsylvania's mercury emissions to air, and our state's power plants are some of the highest emitters nationwide. Yet, coal-fired power plants are the only major mercury polluters that remain uncontrolled.

PADEP's proposed rule would do much to reduce the serious risk to Pennsylvania babies and critical sport fishing industry caused by mercury pollution.

The Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) federal mercury rule will result in more mercury in our air and water than simply fully enforcing the Clean Air Act. PA is currently the 2nd worst polluter of mercury from coal-fired power plants in the country. PA coal is also higher than most in chlorine content which makes it more apt to fall closer to it's source. Our children deserve to grow up in a state that leads the way on reducing mercury pollution. I encourage the adoption of the Department of Environmental Protection's (DEP) proposed PA specific mercury rule which aims to reduce mercury pollution by 80% in 2010 and 90% in 2015 at all applicable sources, and prohibits the trading or netting of mercury pollution credits. We have the opportunity to protect our families' health and safety by implementing a PA specific mercury reduction rule as soon as possible for the sake of our community and our children's health.
