- b. a/c below 85°

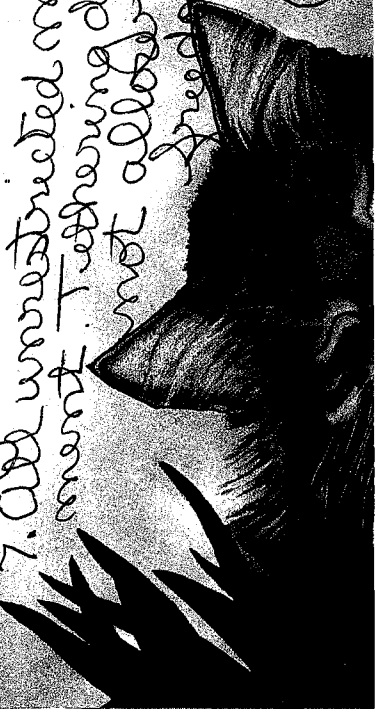
4. improved ventilation and lighting

7. All unrestricted movement. Tethering does not allow dogs freedom.



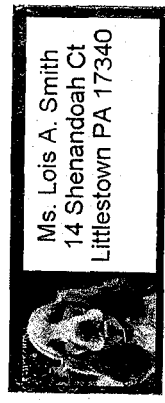
