Dear Ms. Mary Bender,

I strongly support the amendments to the Bureau of Dog Law Regulations.

My primary concerns are -

1. Doubling the cage requirements that currently exist.
2. Provide 20 minutes of exercise time daily for each dog.
3. Provide heat when temperatures drop below 50 degrees and cooling when temperatures rise above 85 degrees.
4. Provide better lighting and frequent air changes for ventilation.
5. Remove all dogs from their cages/kennels during cleaning.
6. "Please" Deny kennel licenses for those convicted of animal cruelty within the past 10 years.
7. "Permanent tethering can not be used as the primary closure"
