Dear Ms. Bender,

I am writing about the proposed changes to the Pennsylvania Dog Law Rules & Regulations. As a dog lover, I rely on private breeders as a source for finding a healthy pet. If the new changes are passed it will be almost impossible for private, small breeders to comply, thereby forcing them out of business. This will have a trickle-down effect that may, in the end, provide a source for the unscrupulous breeders we all hope to eliminate.

Additionally, these changes would place unreasonable constraints on groups such as breed rescue organizations, who may temporarily need to house a large number of dogs. I would hate to think that such groups would be unable to continue their vital work because of government regulations.
