I am writing to ask that that your office give more thought to these unreasonable proposals. Don't give the good breeders in PA this much of a hard time trying to do what they do Well. She is actually afraid she will have to reconsider breeding if she will not be allowed to breed puppies in her home. The small hobby breeders do a great job for us puppy buyers Many of them have worked hard to bring their breeding programs to the point where things are going great. And it will be big loss if she gives up breeding because of rule that would make her compromise her principles.
