When I hung up I really felt sorry for what the Dept. of Agriculture is doing to good people like her.

I do feel that although the old regulations may need a little tweaking, if they were enforced, as they should be, there might not be a need for more rules.

I respectfully ask that your office rethink these unreasonable proposals and give the responsible breeders the respect they deserve. Many of them have worked hard to earn that respect. I know you couldn't find a better, more caring breeder than the one I was lucky to find. And it will be PA and min. schnauzer buyer's loss if she gives up breeding her dogs.
