I am a concerned citizen, and now a very busy retired Pediatrician in Lancaster. I hope this letter does not reach you too late, and serves a purpose. I am involved at the present time in the development of a Lancaster County Health Department. I also have a lot of concern for the pups of Pennsylvania, and in particular those poor souls in the Lancaster County puppy mills.

I could send you a prepared letter of support for the proposed changes of the Dog Law regulations, but you are well aware of those proposals and I am in 100% support of them. I love dogs, and for years have found ours in the local Humane Leagues. Several years ago I changed course and became involved in greyhound rescue. We recently adopted numbers six and seven. I know and Maggie, if they could, would also support the proposals.

Recently I became involved with the local anti puppy mill group, and have attended several zoning board meetings where the kennel owners would be applying for something they were already involved with. What a tragedy for these poor animals. Filthy kennels with lack of proper medical care, lack of proper nutrition, lack of socialization, lack of exercise, no air-conditioning, no heat in some cases, no fire alarms, etc. Most of all a LACK OF LOVE.

Some of those involved did not know which end of the dogs barked – I would bet. The most disturbing thing was a lot of them did not know the meaning of the word TRUTH. I have worked closely with the farmers because I started child farm safety in this area, and now know they have the same weaknesses as we English:
