Dear Governor Rendell:

I am writing in favor of the proposed regulatory proposals doubling cage sizes and requiring operators of kennels to exercise dogs for 20 minutes each day, as well as all other supportive proposals. The inhumane conditions being endured by the breeding dogs and their puppies at the "puppy mills" located primarily in Lancaster County and being run primarily by the Amish and Mennonite, are atrocious and must be changed immediately.
