Dear Bureau (S):

The professional breeders, who are breeding dogs (and cats, and other animals) for sale should be held to the highest standards possible; and if they can't afford it they should not be in the business.

There are far too many people in the business of breeding too many dogs and cats, for money, as it is. We have a serious over-population of dogs and cats - there are not enough homes for them all! The 'shelters' are overloaded with dogs and cats, many of whom are pure-bred.
