Dear Ms. Mary Bender:

We have some concerns pertaining to the proposed AH Kennel Rules.

1. Puppy mills mostly run by Amish are the biggest concern of people in AH. The abuse, neglect and killing of dogs by these people is out of control.
2. The new regs + rules should close most if not all of these places. They will never care for these helpless dogs as you are proposing.
3. They only care about how much money they can make on each puppy by overbreeding the females. We believe limits on how many times you can breed a female dog should be limited to once every 2 yrs. and no more than 3 times.

old. Also, limit these
Amish to only 1 breed of
dog and lower number
of breeding dogs.

No chicken coops or
chicken wire -
Stop them from starving dogs
that cannot breed anymore
or shooting them.

Stop them from ramming
steel rods down their throats
to stop them from barking.

Stop the beatings.
Allow no long haired
dogs since they need
groomed.

4. Volunteered for many years
w/ state approved rescues
and have taken some of
these helpless dogs from
puppy mills & have seen
the horrible abuse.
overcrowded pens, filthy
conditions...

5. Stop shipment of puppies
at illegal ages of 5-6 wks
to pet stores where 70%
die before arriving.
Close Pet Stores + Puppymills
operate from good breeders
and rescues.

6. Stop euthanization in these
kill shelters and make
it mandatory they allow
qualified rescues, approved
by the State, to pull dogs
before euthanizing.

7. Support non-profit rescues
in all townships and counties.
Help them with grant monies,
for they are the organizations
cleaning up the messes
from puppy mills + pet stores.

8. Since non-profits do not make
any profits for vetting, housing,
training, transporting and
caring for dogs + pups they
should be exempt from any

fees or expenses to the
State other than applying
for a license.
