In regards to the proposed amendment it does not address accepting ACT 48 credits as cont Ed Credits evenly ( 1 hour =1hour). The contract should spell out that ACT 48 providers and ACT 48 providers approved courses should be accepted as meeting the requirements for equal Cont Ed Courses.RN's need to be addressed who are in the school setting.

School nurses who as certified education specialists are required to obtain continuing professional education under section 1205.2 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,No.14), known as the "Public School Code of 1949," and under this act, shall be permitted to submit evidence of the completion of education courses approved for their certification by the school district.
