I am a Registered Nurse (licensed in multiple states) currently practicing in PA and Find myself distressed that PA has segregated the nursing profession, "silently" stating that nurses at the bedside, passing medications, doing treatments (usually the Licensed Practical Nurse) are not required to show proof of continued education thru CEU's as are registered nurses, (yet we entrust the care of residents, elderly and patients to them).

As a State, PA, is considering changing the terminology so Licensed Practical Nurses can do "Assessments"; also considering expanding their ability with IV therapy (especially in Home care), yet we DO NOT REQUIRE THEIR CONTINUED EDUCATION?

All states that I am licensed in, "Nurses" are required to complete CEU's for their License renewal ..NOT PA!
