Dear Mr. Buckheit:

As a parent of two children who received special education services in Fairview, Pennsylvania for twenty years and as a parent/advocate, I submit to you my suggestions for improvement on the proposed regulations.

- Please prohibit prone restraints. They are dangerous and deadly. They become totally unnecessary when the schools implement the practice of using positive behavioral supports instead. The latter should be listed on the IEP.
- Eliminate the provision that defines a restraint as something that lasts at least 30 seconds in a row. Also make it mandatory that schools inform parents of the restraint, meet with them, and issue a detailed incident report starting with antecedents and the staff responses along the way.
- Student evaluations should be conducted within 60 calendar days, not school days. There are limited "windows of opportunity" available to children and to force them to wait any longer would cause harm.
- Eliminate the two-tier appeal system in Special Education due process procedures. Put some quality into a single tier system.
- The Dispute Resolution Office should be funded and operated separate from the Dept. of The Education in order to eliminate a conflict of interest. Families need all the **unbiased** help they can get.

- Support the new provision that clarifies the rules on Least Restrictive Environment. Nothing is more damaging to a child's self esteem than segregating him or her from their peers.
- The burden of proof in a Due Process proceeding should be on the schools not on the parents.
