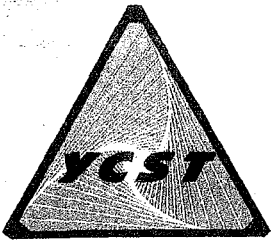
Dear Ms. Staller,

I received your letter and wanted to take a moment to share a couple of thoughts on Basic Cosmetology Curriculum 7.129:

- Under BASIC COSMETOLOGY CURRICULUM, Cosmetology Skills-Cognitive and Manipulative
- Shampooing and Conditioning (today we usually do not shampoo with out conditioning or applying crème rinse)*
- Conditioning Treatments (up-date term we use today instead of scalp treatment)*
- Hair Shaping & Texturizing*
- Hair Styling – Braiding, Finger Waving, Roller Setting, Pin Curling, Combing Out, Air Forming, Thermal Pressing, Thermal Curling, Wigs and Extensions*
- Chemical Texturizing – (up-date term used to include Permanent Waving, Chemical Relaxing, and Curl Reformation)*
- Hair Coloring
- Care of all hair types and textures
- Skin Care
- Temporary Hair Removal
- Makeup Application (missing)*
- Nail Treatments (instead of just manicuring, most cosmetology schools to my knowledge and the Milady textbook include, pedicuring, wraps, and artificial nail applications)*

Under 7.129.(c), Teacher Curriculum is it still necessary to have Salon Management Theory since the Manager's License law change? A cosmetologist would have it as a part of their curriculum, "Business Practices."

Under 7.129.(e) Cosmetician, 7.129.(f) Manicuring, and Natural Hair Braiding should each of these have Business Practices added? In addition it says Professional Practices and Sciences but there are no topics? Shouldn't these be listed similar to Cosmetology for the limited licenses with topics for Professional Practices and Sciences?

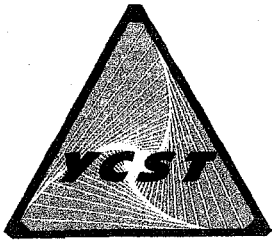
