As licensed prescribers in the state of Pennsylvania and Advance Practice Nurses, the Pennsylvania Coalition of Nurse Practitioners (Coalition) would like to take the opportunity to provide comments on the proposed regulations that would affect our certified nurse midwife (CNM) colleagues. From a professional standpoint, the passing of Act 50 by Governor Rendell was another excellent measure to improve access to care for women and children in our state. Our nurse midwife colleagues have excellent records of safety and effectively providing holistic care to women of childbearing age, often times being the only available provider in underserved areas to safely care for and bring a women's pregnancy to full term.
