Michael: Reviewed the final rulemaking for Regulation 17-75 (IRRC #2661), 'Retired Law Enforcement Identification Card" and offer the following comments. First, we appreciate the response by the MPOETC on our questions when the regulations were first proposed. As indicated in the response to IRRC we are satisfied with their comments. The only issue we have is the estimated cost to local government to comply with the proposal. MPOETC estimates that it will cost the regulated community \$88,000 per year for the next five years and the state between \$61,000 and \$44,700 per year for the next five years, but gives no estimate what it will cost local government, both counties and municipalities. This is after they indicate that the "law enforcement agency must bear the cost of providing the I.D. cards." We would have liked to see their estimate of what this may cost local government?
