Regulation No. 31-11 (#2668) State Employees' Retirement Board Death Benefits

On January 18, 2008, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this proposed regulation from the State Employees' Retirement Board (Board). This rulemaking amends 4 Pa. Code § 249.7. The proposed regulation was published in the February 2, 2008 *Pennsylvania Bulletin* with a 30-day public comment period. The final-form regulation was submitted to the Commission on January 14, 2010.

This final-form regulation clarifies that a nomination of beneficiary must be in writing on a form supplied by the Board.

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of the Board (71 Pa.C.S. § 5902(h)) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.
