#### <u>Preamble</u>

The State Employees' Retirement Board ("Board") proposes to amend 4 Pa. Code, Chapter 241 by amending Section 241.1 regarding the definition of "beneficiary" to read as set forth in Annex A.

#### A. Effective Date

This amendment will be effective upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* as a final rulemaking.

# Annex A TITLE 4. ADMINISTRATION PART X. STATE EMPLOYES' RETIREMENT BOARD CHAPTER 241. PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

#### 4 Pa. Code §241.1

§ 241.1. Definitions.

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Beneficiary – The person or persons, as defined in 1 Pa.C.S. §1991 (relating to the General Provisions of Statutory Construction), last designated in writing to the Board by a member to receive his the member's accumulated deductions or a lump sum benefit upon the death of such the member. If one is not designated, the recipient shall be the estate of the member or next of kin under 20 Pa.C.S. § 3101 (relating to payments to family and funeral directors), to the extent applicable.
