By publication in the April 3, 2010 *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission has reopened the comment period on the above regulation to accept additional public comments until June 2, 2010. Consequently, we want to bring three things to your attention. First, this Commission may comment on the reopened regulation by July 2, 2010, under 1 Pa. Code § 305.3(c)(2). Second, please submit to this Commission and the Standing Committees, within five days of receipt, copies of comments received during the reopened comment period. (See 71 P.S. §745.5(c).) Finally, the reopening of the public comment period resets the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's two-year window to complete the rulemaking to June 2, 2012, under 1 Pa. Code § 305.3(c)(3).
