They have the 4sight four times a year and then two weeks of PSSA testing. The PSSA test is, in my opinion < not very worthwhile. I know several students (in addition to one of my daughters) that scored as "not proficient" on the PSSA, yet she is in all honors classes and has received straight A's in all subjects.

I know several exemplary students that have gone on to prestigious colleges and done very well, but they did not do well on the PSSA. I think the PSSA is not a well developed test.

Please do not support a High School graduation exam. Pennsylvania has enough testing as it is. Some students just do not test well, but that is not a true representation of their knowledge or abilities.
