Resolved, that the Board of School Directors of the Lower Merion, School District opposes the recent proposal by the Pennsylvania State Board of Education to enact a set of Graduation Competency Assessments as a condition to graduation, and opposes any regulations or other legislation that impose additional standardized testing as a condition to graduation or otherwise change graduation requirements consistent with such proposal; and
