

## RE: Proposed Regulations—"Keystone Exams"

Dear Mr. Kaufman and Members of the Commission:

The members of the North Allegheny Board of School Directors continue to oppose the proposed regulations for Academic Standards and Assessments (known as "Keystone Exams"). We previously explained our opposition in a formal Board resolution and correspondence from our Board President. These documents are posted on your website.

As the largest suburban school district in Allegheny County, we believe that our community stands behind us in our opposition to this intrusion into local control. We also know that our neighboring school districts share our concerns. This is well-documented on your website.

Last year you declined to approve the proposed regulations for the graduate competency exams (GCA's) for many of the same reasons that still exist today.

We hope you will consider the overwhelming and wide-ranging opposition to these tests. We believe that there is a better way to approach the issue of continuing to improve student achievement. Once these regulations are defeated, we would be happy to be part of the process as opposed to having the process be dictated to us.
